Christa Schwarz, 2003-07-18 Heretofore scholars have not been willing perhaps even been unable for many reasons both academic and personal to identify much of the Harlem Renaissance work as same sex oriented An important book Jim Elledge This groundbreaking study explores the Harlem Renaissance as a literary phenomenon fundamentally shaped by same sex interested men Christa Schwarz focuses on Count e Cullen Langston Hughes Claude McKay and Richard Bruce Nugent and explores these writers sexually dissident or gay literary voices The portrayals of men loving men in these writers works vary significantly Schwarz locates in the poetry of Cullen Hughes and McKay the employment of contemporary gay code words deriving from the Greek discourse of homosexuality and from Walt Whitman By contrast Nugent the only out gay Harlem Renaissance artist portrayed men loving men without reference to racial concepts or Whitmanesque codes Schwarz argues for contemporary readings attuned to the complex relation between race gender and sexual orientation in Harlem Renaissance writing *The Cambridge Companion to Gay and Lesbian Writing* Hugh Stevens, 2011 In the last two decades lesbian and gay studies have transformed literary studies The Cambridge Companion to Gay and Lesbian Writing introduces readers to important concepts methods and cultural and historical debates relevant to the study of sexuality and literature

The Wallflower Avant-garde Brian Glavey, 2016 *The Wallflower Avant Garde* argues for the importance of a strain of modernist formalism based in ekphrasis the literary imitation of the visual arts Often associated with a conservative aesthetic of wholeness permanence and autonomy ekphrastic writing also involves excess failure and mimesis conjuring an aesthetic sense of closure and unity out of impossible imitations This choreography of imitation and autonomy resonates with many of the foundational insights of queer theory the way it situates identity as an effect of performativity artifice and mimesis Unlike many queer theorists however this book insists that we value both the imitations and the aspirations that guide them underlining not only the illusoriness of identity but also its allure This more capacious formalism allows aspects of modernists aesthetic that have seemed regressive or repressive to be read as generative forms of stasis quiet reserve shyness and so on

argues that Baldwin animates and in contrast disrupts both the black gay literary tradition and the queer theoretical enterprise that have claimed him More paradoxically even as Baldwin s fiction brilliantly succeeds in imagining queer intersections of race and sexuality it simultaneously exhibits striking queer failures whether exploiting gay love or erasing black lesbian desire Brim thus argues that Baldwin s work is deeply marked by ruptures of the unqueer into transcendent queer thought and that readers must sustain rather than override this paradoxical dynamic within acts of queer imagination
