Differences in race and gender further stratified life opportunities for the Baltimore children As one of the first studies to closely examine the outcomes of inner city whites in addition to African Americans data from the BSSYP shows that by adulthood white men of lower status family background despite attaining less education on average were more likely to be employed than any other group in part due to family connections and long standing racial biases in Baltimore's industrial economy Gender imbalances were also evident the women who were more likely to be working in low wage service and clerical jobs earned less than men African American women were doubly disadvantaged insofar as they were less likely to be in a stable relationship than white women and therefore less likely to benefit from a second income Combining original interviews with Baltimore families teachers and other community members with the empirical data gathered from the authors groundbreaking research The Long Shadow unravels the complex connections between socioeconomic origins and socioeconomic destinations to reveal a startling and much needed examination of who succeeds and why African American Families Linda M.
