The ongoing issue with *Traditions & Encounters* is its number of chapters. Most schools begin in late August or early September, leaving ~30 weeks to get through the book if you want any time for review before the exam. Yet there are 35 chapters in the Bentley book, down from 40, but still not whittled down enough to fit a standard-length course, especially if you want to enjoy any semblance of structure. This means it is up to the individual teacher to combine 5 or so chapters. What follows is a recommendation as to how, along with a brief from the past of how this course was ordered when it was young.
