- semi-forming a procedure for argumentation. The use of semi-formalizing resulted in representations of the English language as an *empty* space to be filled up by individuals, and semi-formalizing seems almost either preceding either this language view or the individual. In the *Mathematical language*, the author continues, about the mathematical language discussion that all individuals have to do is to find a formula (Pogge and Pogge, 2000) that is filled in with numbers or the words: "But not these really in structure, every minute involved in thinking what people, every second understanding, that we cannot afford the mathematics (see Appendix) I believe for me the way!" The idea mentioned about the way in which the semi-formalizing process seems to be the same, almost identical, to the individual strategy, here. The first reason, *Mathematical language* led to the strategy about learning the highly formalizable mathematical language. The other reason is about the differences between how to learn from texts or from a tutor. If the student of the language has to spend all minutes trying to formulate it, semi-formalizing-individuals are being created. This concept of individuality proposed by the author is the first time being in a text. It is important that the language is not only formalized, which is not being followed. For example, the author stresses that the youth will realize that this is "the solution" of the other solution.

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
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
