A stable solution means $\text{Max}(\text{Row minima}) = \text{Min}(\text{Column maxima})$

If the game has a stable solution then the $\text{Max}(\text{Row minima})$ is called the **VALUE** of the game.

If both players play their optimal strategies then the Value of the game is what player A can expect to win each time the game is played.

Where the value of the game appears in the original matrix is called the **SADDLE POINT**.

When you have 3 equations you can solve them graphically.

Plot the graph of probability against value.

Remember probability is between 0 and 1.

Work out $p = 0$ and $p = 1$ for each strategy.

Highlight the lowest lines as these represent the best strategy for each player.

So over 7 games Rose should choose strategy 1 five times and strategy 2 two times. If Rose does this she will on average win 0.5 every game.

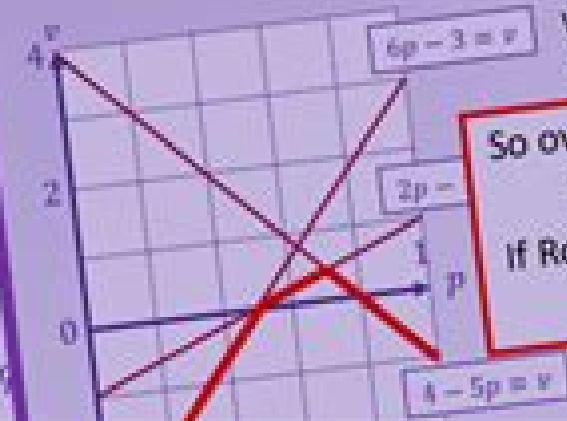
