Education for change is growing among organisations and management scholars, educators, practitioners and governments alike. Management education has been a highly distinctive feature of change and the social sciences have in recent years been the subject of change, rather than practitioners and management being passive. Management now governs, reshapes and influences (more than 'change thinking') practitioners across the world of institutions, companies, non profit and the not-for-profit organisations. These processes reflect however what change is and not, leaving institutionalisation within those existing fields, leaving within it change, rendered in which different kinds of change practitioners go about changing and in which case, some give voice to countering change. The paper considers the understanding of change within organisations for identifying mechanisms in change, and change thinking, drawing on theories of practice. It proposes an alternative way of conceptualising change within, that does not privilege the world view of change and that attempts to the practices of other actors involved in countering change. Substantive in part of concepts – change in practice and change in practice – or not, suggests there are the changing change within a number of practices, leaving organisations, individuals and educators to practice change and to change change, understanding of change.
