Everyday Evil in Stephen King's America Jason S. Polley, Stephanie Laine Hamilton, 2024-06-03 This edited collection variously interrogates how everyday evil manifests in Stephen King's now familiar American imaginary an imaginary that increases the representational limits of both anticipated and experienced realism Divided into three parts I The Man II The Monster and III The Re mediator the book offers rigorous readings of evil realism and popular culture as represented in a range of texts and paratexts from the King canon Rich with images a photo essay and appendices collecting classical texts and cultural detritus germane to King this book moves away from viewing King's work primarily through the lens of the
