For the past two decades Palestinians have chosen to pursue their claims against the Israeli occupation through litigation at the international courts. It is therefore appropriate the author contends to analyze the merits of the Palestinian legal claims separately from their political claims. To do so the book comprises five parts. Part I addresses the role of international law in the conflict as well as Palestinian legal framing and lawfare. Part II recounts the relevant legal history including the crucial legal implications of the Oslo Accords. Part III analyzes Palestinian legal claims regarding the West Bank and the Gaza Strip.
