INTRODUCTION

Infrared spectroscopy is the study of the interaction of light (infrared electromagnetic energy) with matter. The spectrum of infrared radiation covers the absorption of infrared energy by molecules and provides information about the chemical structure of a sample. A typical spectral range of 4000 to 600 cm⁻¹ is used for the identification of unknown samples and comparison with known samples. This range is divided into two regions: the fingerprint region (below 1500 cm⁻¹) and the functional group region (above 1500 cm⁻¹).

ELECTROMAGNETIC SPECTRUM

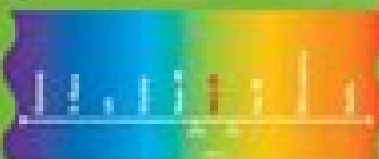

Speed of light (c) is a constant, approximately 3.0 x 10⁸ m/s. Wavelength (λ) is measured in meters (m) and frequency (ν) is measured in inverse meters (m⁻¹).
