# Doing Business in the Philippines

The Philippines is the gateway to the vast flourishing markets of the ASEAN nations. Despite their long history dating back to the Spanish colonial period and their status as the largest, in terms of area, of the Netherlands' most successful export, the fact that Manila has become the largest metropolitan in southeast Asian gives importance to the Philippines. Many investors intend to explore the Philippines and its people, its language and resources, a developing infrastructure for regional growth, a flourishing tourism and service sector, access to water & food.

The Philippine economy withstood the recent global economic downturn better than any other ASEAN country. Apart from being heavily affected by international economic, the Philippines enjoys rampant domestic consumption, low dependence on exports and large amounts of remittances flowing into the country from the millions of Filipinos working abroad. With a stable banking system, a well performing stock market, a constantly expanding tourism, manufacturing industry and record high levels of international reserves, the prospects for the Philippine economy remain positive. Furthermore, the Asian Development Bank (ADB), which offers a broad range of business opportunities in the region is located in Manila. These indicators, in combination with a low-key rate of inflation as high as 10%, being taught in an online provides many business opportunities for Dutch entrepreneurs. This is particularly true for the service and tourism sector.

## Priority sectors

### Transport & Infrastructure

While challenges remain in the area of public infrastructure, the increased public spending on infrastructure has led to less serious transportation impediments through better roads and more flights.

The next few years will see additional investments from the government and increasing private investments in the Philippine transport sector. The Philippines is also developing other facilities to be an international gateway to being an all-Asian region with domestic and international flights. Due to the growing importance in transport and logistics, business opportunities for Dutch companies can be explored for airport and port development, warehousing and express facilities for sea-food, horticulture and other products (e.g. cold storage, freezing, post-harvest storage facilities).

### Maritime

The Netherlands and the Philippines have strong and long-standing bilateral political and economic cooperation in the maritime sector. The Philippines is the "crossing point of the world" and is the primary source of seafarers for the Dutch fleet. The country's strategic nature makes it a strategic hub for ports, shipping and maritime regulation within the Asia-Pacific region. Given the substantial economic increase expected for the Asian shipping sector, more and more Dutch shipping companies are seeking to expand their business presence in the Philippines instead of just partnering with local transport agencies. Similarly, both governments strongly tend the need to continue on Manila Agreements (MANA), a high-level bilateral meeting to strengthen maritime cooperation.

Dr. THIRUMALAICHELVAM SUBRAMANIAM, 2019-04-22 Barriers to commercial and industrial energy efficiency improvements in Klang Valley Malaysia are more pronounced due to the existence of factors such as weak policy and regulatory frameworks economic and financial constraints lack of information and other issues This research utilized a qualitative research methodology using a phenomenology approach aimed at enhancing the knowledge of commercial and industrial energy efficiency in Klang Valley Malaysia by investigating the barriers associated with the implementation of energy efficiency measure The eleven main themes and twenty eight sub themes identified from the study revealed that energy is poorly managed in the various commercial and industrial sectors and that there is an energy efficiency gap resulting from the low implementation of energy efficiency measures In addition the study revealed that the

most important factors impeding the implementation of cost effective energy efficiency technologies in the organizations are principally economic and financial barriers such as lack of budget funding and access to capital The study also revealed that these economic and financial barriers are linked to the lack of adequate government framework for commercial and industrial energy efficiency The study also showed that market factors related to cost reductions resulting from lowered energy use and threats of rising energy prices are the most important drivers for adapting energy efficiency technologies To motivate energy efficiency there should be established standards guidelines roadmaps regulations and enforcement of regulation suitable for the local environment which at present has not been executed completely in Malaysia
