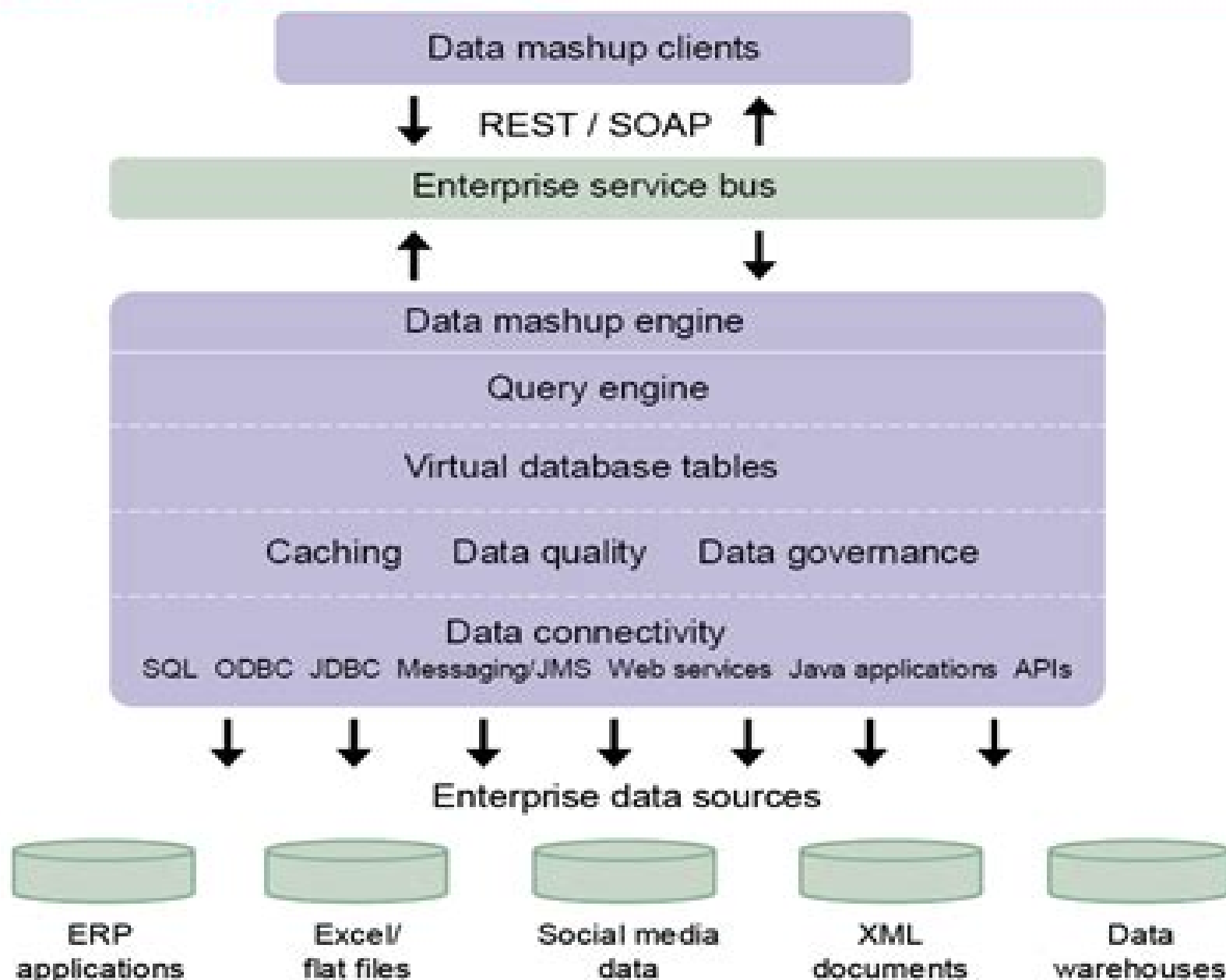


Figure 1: Anatomy of a data mashup
