Animal bodies are provided with defenses at the body surface. In addition, there are systems within the body that trap and then eliminate any material that succeeds in getting through the outer defenses.

These trapping systems employ cells that can **bind**, **ingest** and **destroy** foreign material through a process known as phagocytosis.

The Russian scientist Eli Metchnikoff discovered phagocytosis in 1882.
