Abstract

In this chapter, I develop Aristotle's argument humans are by nature political animals. I follow the logic of the Machiavellian Intelligence hypotheses and the contention that human intelligence developed out of pressure to be more politically savvy than your rivals. I then describe a neural architecture that would allow higher primates to monitor their social surroundings and theorize about the mental states of potential rivals and review evidence that this same neural architecture is used by modern political sophisticates to think about national politics. I contend that this evidence requires political science to revisit our understandings of political sophistication and political cognition in light of a brain that was built for politics.
