Function over phylogeny

Analysis of bacterial communities inhabiting water 'tanks' in the foliage of tropical bromeliads reveals a surprising similarity in their metabolic capacity, despite large variation in microbial taxa.

in the macroscopic world, grasslands, forests, and deserts have different species compositions on different continents. These geographically separated ecosystems all contain primary producers, herbivores, and carmivores in roughly equal proportion. However, the taxonomic identities of these organisms are different (redwoods in North America, kangaroos in Australia, tigers in Assa). The reasons for these differences are historical. Species evolved independently in each isolated region to fill the available ecological roles. Thus, ecosystem function is conserved while species identities vary.

In this issue, Louca et al. report that aquatic microbial community assembly is non-random and can be better predicted by inferred functional characteristics than by species composition. This result mirrors what we see in macrosystems, but unlike macroorganisms the authors found no evidence of dispersal limitation, where more similar communities are generally found closer together in the environment. In the absence of dispersal limits, what alternative ecological models could explain this observed variability in species composition?




Figure 1 | Aquatic microbial communities inhabiting bromeliad 'tanks', a. The bromeliad Aschmes nuclicadis (green) collects rainwater (blue) and distribus (brown) in a 'tank' formed by overlapping leaves in the centre of the plant, from which total community ONA is sequenced and physicochemical conditions are characterized. b. Simple traits encoded by a single gene (like sugar catabolism) are easily transferred. More complex traits that require many genes (like photoautotrophy) are restricted to the clades where they arose (for example syamobacterial). This tree is purely illustrative and does not represent real physiogenetic data. Parel b adapted from ref. ", Elsevier.

Distinguishing between alternative models of community assembly requires independent replicate ecosystems. Louca et al. investigate microbial communities associated with the bromeliad Acolomes modicands randomly distributed around 20 hectures of the Jurubatiba National Park in Brazil. Bromeliads are tropical plants, many of which store water in the base of overlapping leaves at their centre known as the 'tank', where rainfall and detritus collect (Fig. 1a).

To assess microbial community composition, the authors entract and sequence total community DNA from the tanks, each of which they find have similar physical and chemical properties across the sampling area. By assigning sequences to functional groups based on a manually curated database that maps taxonomic identities to metabolic traits, they find that the functional structure of the bromeliad communities is remarkably stable, despite

high taxonomic variability between tanks. This lack of conservation between taxonomy and functional traits is likely due to horizontal gene transfer (gene swapping between unrelated organisms)*, which is quite common in bacteria (Fig. 1b).

While functional consistency across replicate environments suggests nonrandom community assembly, this lack of taxonomic consistency could be due to random demographic processes like dispersal limitation. However, they find no strong relationship between taxonomic dissimilarity and geographic distance. This implies that dispersal limitation is not responsible for the taxonomic variability between bromeliads' tank communities.

This result fits well with recent work showing the cosmopolitan distribution of aquatic microorganisms. An alternative explanation for taxonomic turnover across replicate environments could be the influence of priority effects, where the initial colonization and growth of one taxon excludes the establishment of another functionally similar organism. Priority effects have previously been shown to impact the dominance of genetically identical strains expressing different coloured fluorescent proteins in simple microbial ecosystems. In this context, as a new beomeliad gross and forms its tank, those bacteria that happen to colonize first would hit the jackpot, filling the available miche space.

Finally, minor physicochemical differences between bromeliad tanks could also drive taxonomic variability, tipping the competitive scale ever so slightly between different microorganisms that inhabit a similar metabolic niche. This latter hypothesis seems unlikely, as the authors find that less than 5% of the community variance could be explained by measured environmental factors — though it is of course possible that unmeasured environmental variables may be responsible for the observed species beterogeneity.
