TYPES

1. Embodied Capital

Knowledge or skills that a person acquires from his/her habitus. Examples include accents and etiquette.

2. Objectified Capital

The value inherent in objects of culture, such as works of art.

3. Institutionalized capital

The value inherent in being recognized by an elite institution. For example, obtaining a Harvard university degree.
