Suppose that a rare disease has an incidence of 1 in 1000 personyears. Assuming that members of the population are affected independently, find the probability of k cases in a population of 10,000 (followed over 1 year) for k=0,1,2.

The expected value (mean) = $\lambda = .001*10,000 = 10$ 10 new cases expected in this population per year

$$P(X = 0) = \frac{(10)^{0} e^{-(10)}}{0!} = .0000454$$

$$P(X = 1) = \frac{(10)^{1} e^{-(10)}}{1!} = .000454$$

$$P(X = 2) = \frac{(10)^{2} e^{-(10)}}{2!} = .00227$$
