 - A. Try hard to speak the way they do for better understanding.
 - B. Bring them to places the country is well-known for.
 - C. Serve them the same food that they eat in their country.
 - D. Show them desirable Filipino traits.

*Conflict may arise when two different cultures meet and interact. In Option A, trying to speak the language of another culture does not promote one's own language nor brings out a sense of nationhood to an individual. Likewise in Option C, Serving the person the food he eats in his own country does not do the country any good.

So, the right answers are Options B & D. Both are positive indicators of love of country. Also, such actions signify the desire to contribute to national well-being by promoting the Philippines through visits to some scenic spots and show of desirable Filipino traits to them.
