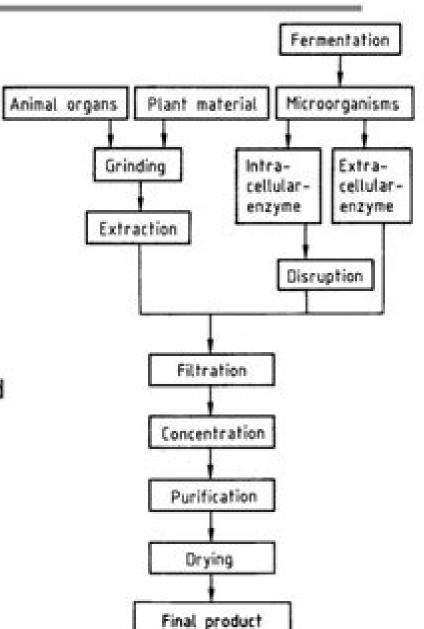
Enzyme Production/Isolation Methods
