The final chapter deals specifically with contemporary novels by women some of which celebrate the inclusiveness of eating and writing while others grapple with the fear of eating Such dread or disgust can be seen as a warning against what the complacent gourmet boom of the 1980s and 1990s concealed the dangers of a market economy environmental destruction and continuing gender biases Reading Food in Modern Japanese Literature will tempt any reader with an interest in food literature and culture Moreover it Woman Critiqued Rebecca L. provides appetizing hints for further savoring digesting and incorporating textual food
