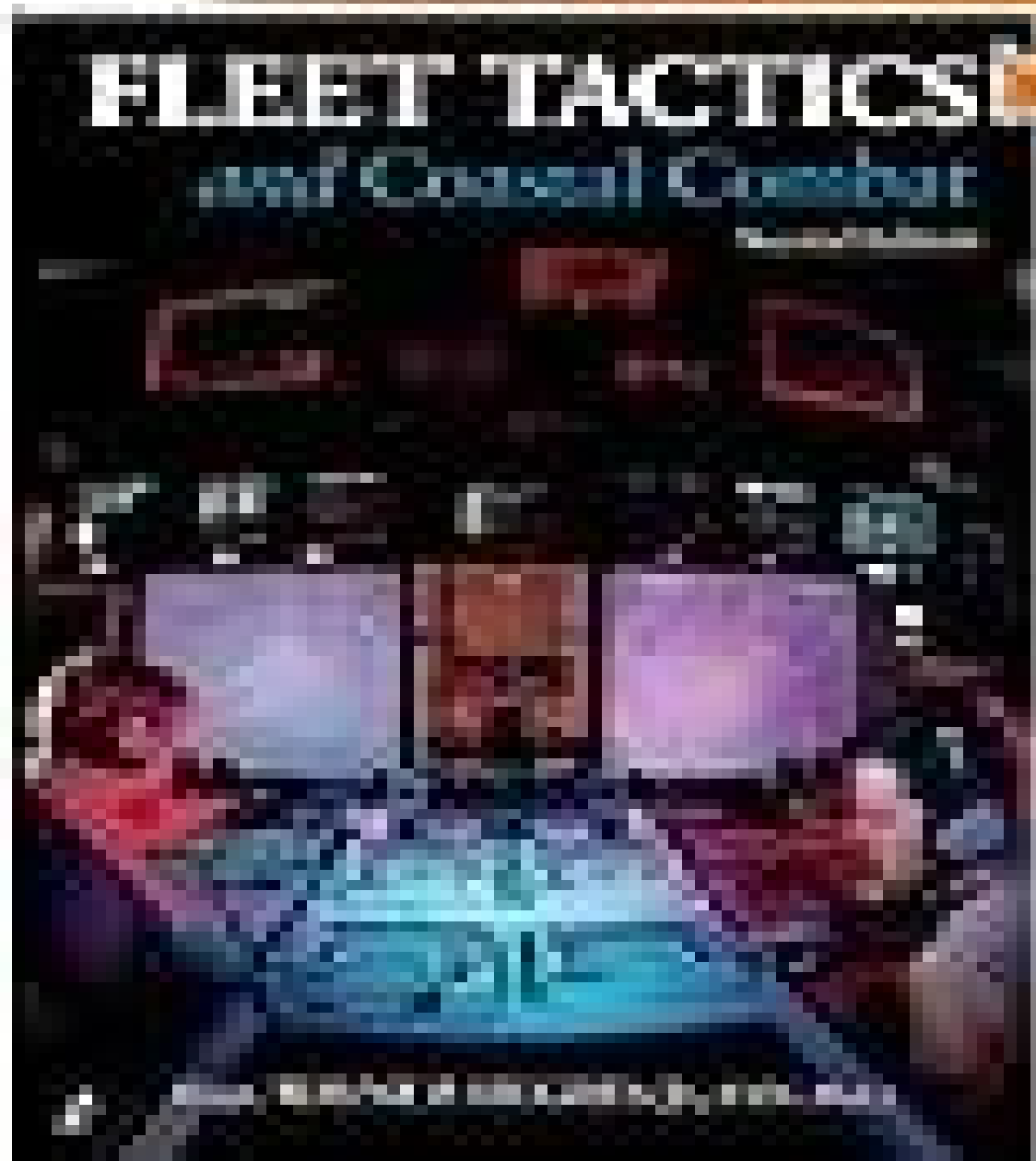

Fleet Tactics and Coastal Combat Wayne Hughes, 2014-08-01 This major revision updates Wayne Hughes's 1986 landmark study that is credited with providing decision makers a sound foundation for battle planning and tactical thinking. The book integrates the historical evolution of tactics analysis and fleet operations and today it can serve as a primer for anyone who wants to learn how navies fight and win. This second edition includes much new material on combat in the missile age and reflects the reconfiguration of many tactics for littoral operations after the fall of the Soviet Union. Hughes recreates famous battles to show how tactics have changed through the ages and the ways in which they have remained unchanged. He covers tactical interaction between land and sea, the sensory revolution of WWII, secret weapons, and maritime surprise, the role in battle of leadership and morale, and the importance of surface warships in today's U.S. fleet. He suggests that naval tactics, unlike ground combat, are dominated by the offense and concludes that the great tactical maxim must be: attack effectively first. A new chapter traces the evolution of missile tactics at sea and includes details of attacks on ships. Many changes emphasize joint operations and coastal combat. The already extensive appraisal of command and control and information warfare is further expanded to cover modern naval operations and the character of modern salvo warfare. In the tradition of Mahan and Clausewitz, this classic text incorporates literature, politics, and a knowledge of human nature. Indispensable reading for all those interested in naval tactics, it is also a valuable reference for wargamers.

Red Star over the Pacific, Second Edition Toshi Yoshihara, James Holmes, 2018-12-15 Combining a close knowledge of Asia and an ability to tap Chinese language sources with naval combat experience and expertise in sea power theory, the authors assess how the rise of Chinese sea power will affect U.S. maritime strategy in Asia. Home Squadron James C. Rentfrow, 2014-04-15 This study examines the transformation of the United States Navy as a fighting organization that took place on the North Atlantic Station between 1874 and 1897. At the beginning of this period, the warships assigned to this station were collectively administered by a rear admiral but were operationally deployed as individual units, each of whose actions were directed by their captains. By 1897, the North Atlantic or Home Squadron, as it was known, was a group of warships constituting a protean battle fleet that is an organized body moving and fighting in close order, which meant that the actions of the captains were directed by a commanding admiral. The process of the development of an American battle fleet resulted in the construction of a new organizational identity for the

North Atlantic Squadron This process was as critical as the eventual outcome It was not linear but one in which progress in critical areas was modulated by conflicting demands that caused distraction From 1874 1888 exercises in fleet tactics under steam were carried out sporadically utilizing existing wooden cruising vessels From 1889 1894 the last wooden cruisers were decommissioned and the Squadron consisted entirely of new steel warships Ad hoc concentrations of vessels for purposes besides exercise and training retarded the continued development of doctrine and tactics necessary for a multi ship fighting capability during this time However much work was done to develop a concept of multi ship operations From 1895 1897 the identity of the North Atlantic Squadron as a combat unit solidified Tactical exercises were held that had specific offensive and defensive wartime applications These exercises were necessary to develop a combat capability The results of this study demonstrate that the United States government had an interest in developing an offensive naval combat capability as early as the 1870 s Based on the record of the North Atlantic Squadron it is argued that imperial aspirations in the sense of possessing a capability to restrict the actions of other great powers in the Caribbean region existed prior to the War of 1898 However the process of change often resulted in the appearance of capability without the rigorous exercise necessary to possess it

The Senkaku Paradox Michael E. O'Hanlon, 2019-04-30 America needs better options for resolving potential crises In recent years the Pentagon has elevated its concerns about Russia and China as potential military threats to the United States and its allies But what issues could provoke actual conflict between the United States and either country And how could such a conflict be contained before it took the world to the brink of thermonuclear catastrophe as was feared during the cold war Defense expert Michael O Hanlon wrestles with these questions in this insightful book setting them within the broader context of hegemonic change and today s version of great power competition The book examines how a local crisis could escalate into a broader and much more dangerous threat to peace What if for example Russia s little green men seized control of a community like Narva or an even smaller town in Estonia now a NATO ally Or what if China seized one of the uninhabited Senkaku islands now claimed and administered by Japan or imposed a partial blockade of Taiwan Such threats are not necessarily imminent but they are far from inconceivable Washington could be forced to choose in these and similar cases between risking major war to reverse the aggression and appeasing China or Russia in ways that could jeopardize the broader global order O Hanlon argues that the United States needs a better range of options for dealing with such risks to peace He advocates integrated deterrence which combines military elements with economic warfare The military components would feature strengthened forward defenses as well as possibly limited military options against Russian or Chinese assets in other theaters Economic warfare would include offensive elements notably sanctions as well as measures to ensure the resilience of the United States and allies against possible enemy reprisal The goal is to deter war through a credible set of responses that are more commensurate than existing policy with the stakes involved in such scenarios
