August Wilson Patti Hartigan, 2024-08-27 The masterful The Wall Street Journal invaluable Los Angeles Times first authoritative biography of August Wilson the most important and successful American playwright of the late 20th century by a theater critic who knew him August Wilson wrote a series of ten plays celebrating African American life in the 20th century one play for each decade No other American playwright has completed such an ambitious oeuvre Two of the plays became successful films Fences starring Denzel Washington and Viola Davis and Ma Rainey's Black Bottom starring Viola Davis and Chadwick Boseman Fences and The Piano Lesson won the Pulitzer Prize for Drama Fences won the Tony Award for Best Play and years after Wilson's death in 2005 Jitney earned a Tony Award for Best Revival of a Play Through his brilliant use of vernacular speech Wilson developed unforgettable characters who epitomized the trials and triumphs of the African American experience He said that he didn't research his plays but wrote them from the blood's memory a sense of racial history that he believed African Americans shared Author and theater critic Patti Hartigan traced his ancestry back to slavery and his plays echo with uncanny similarities to the history of his ancestors She interviewed Wilson many times before his death and traces his life from his childhood in Pittsburgh where nine of the plays take place to Broadway She also

An ideology premised on colorblindness, the notion of the post-racial suggests that the United States has largely achieved racial equality and that race is no longer a central organizing category in American society. Post-racialism is partly responsible for ahistorical, romanticized narratives of slavery, Jim Crow segregation, and American exceptionalism. The legitimacy of this fantasy, the editors contend, was the first casualty of the tanks, tear gas, and rubber bullets wielded against protesters during the summer of 2014. From these protests emerged a new political narrative organized around Black Lives Matter, which directly challenged the fantasy of a post-racial American society.
