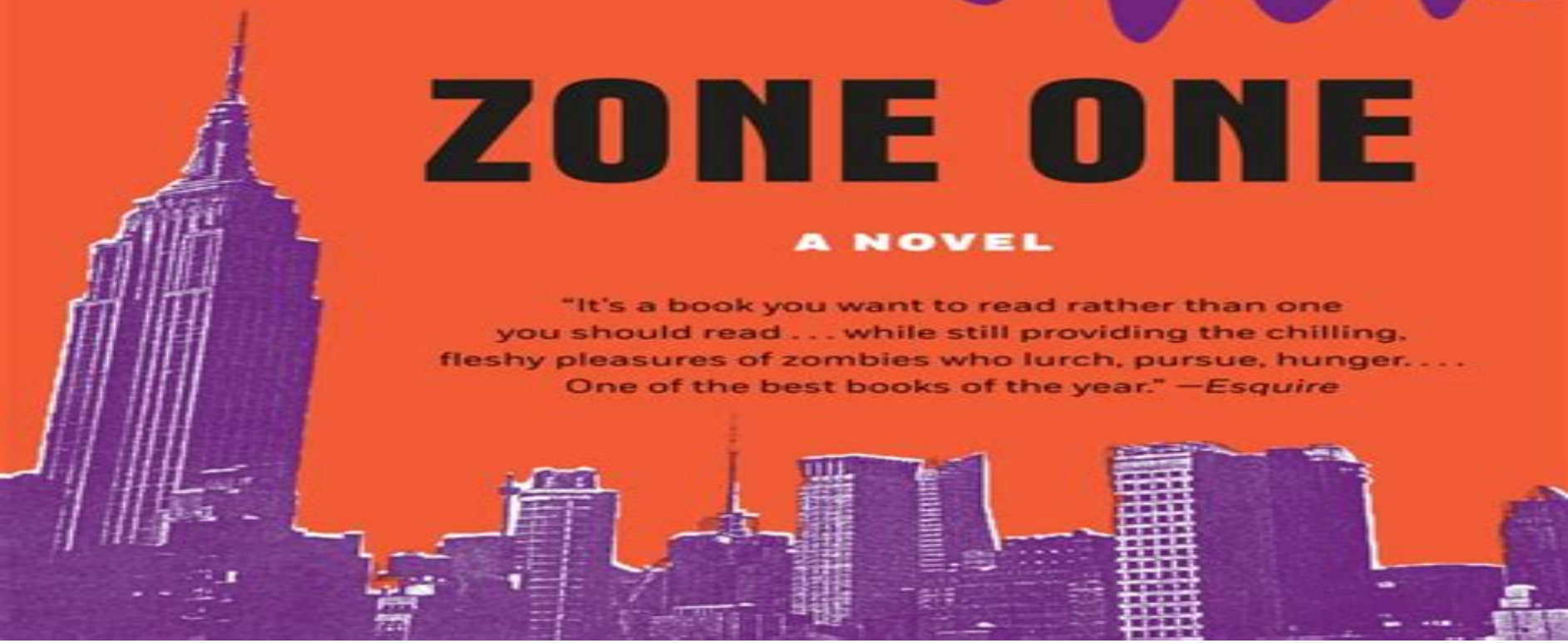

protagonists are well educated and upwardly mobile and thus lack some of the social angst that is imposed by racial stratification.
