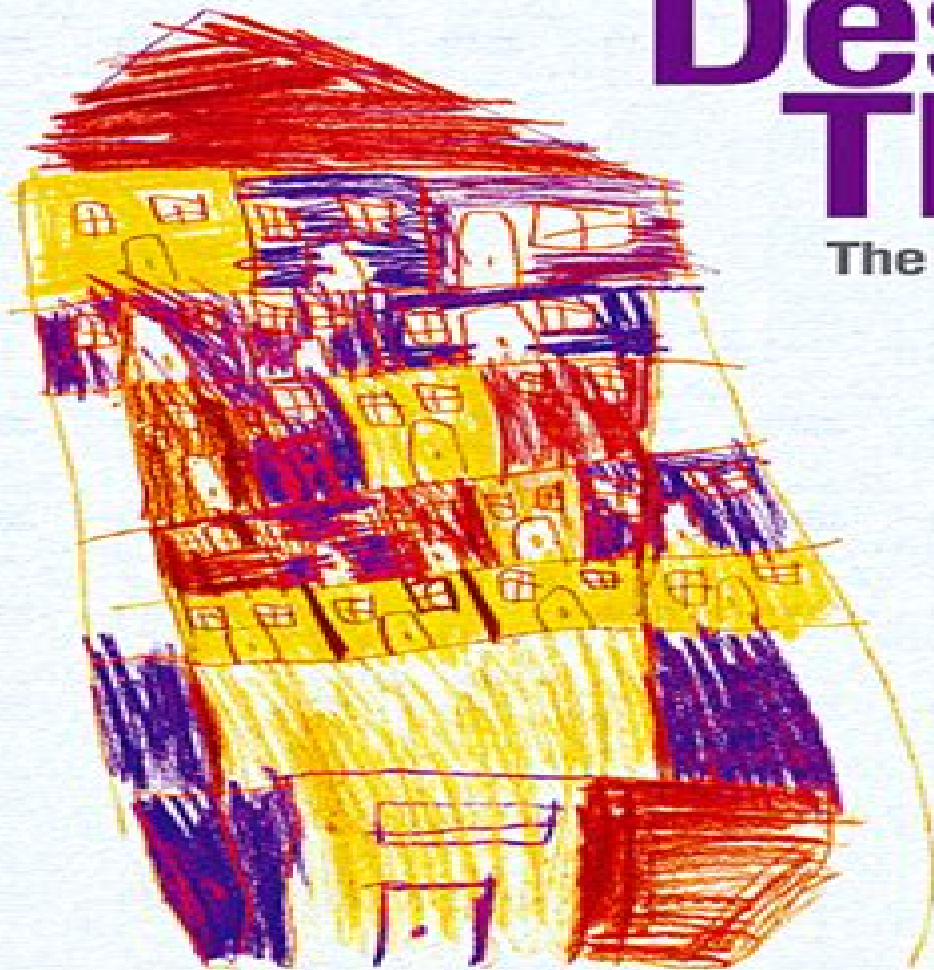

Some of the ideas previously discussed in the third edition of *How Designers Think* are now explored more thoroughly in *What Designers Know*. For the first time, this fourth edition works towards a model of designing and the skills that collectively constitute the design process.
