

LIVER ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY

- The liver is divided into two lobar segments (right and left), and further subdivided into eight (Couinaud) segments based upon vascular supply and bile duct distribution
- The segmental anatomy of the liver is the basis for the various types of anatomic hepatic resections.
- Couinaud's liver segments

(I through VIII) numbered in a clockwise manner. The left lobe includes segments II to IV, the right lobe includes segments V to VIII, and the caudate lobe is segment I. IVC = inferior vena cava


