

CHAPTER 6 - SKELETAL SYSTEM

COMPONENTS:

- *Bones*
- *Joints & Associated Cartilages*

SKELETAL

- Derived from Greek word meaning "*dried*"
- Consist of dynamic, living tissues that are able to grow, detect pain stimuli, adapt to stress & undergo repair after injury.
- FRAMEWORK to support the soft tissues of the body.

MAJOR FUNCTIONS:

1.) SUPPORT

- Major supporting tissues of the body
- **Cartilages** – provides firm yet flexible support (ex. Nose, external ear, thoracic cage & trachea)
- **Ligaments** – strong bands of fibrous connective tissue that attach to bones & hold them together.

2.) PROTECTION

- Protects the organ it surrounds
(Ex. Skull encloses and protects the brain)

3.) MOVEMENT

- **Tendons** – skeletal muscles attach to bones
- **Smooth Cartilages** – covers the ends of bones within some joints ; allowing the bones to move freely
- **Ligaments** – allow some movements between bones but prevent excessive movements

4.) STORAGE

- **Calcium & Phosphorus** – taken into bones and stored
- * **Adipose tissue** – stored w/in bone cavities (fats)
- **Lipids** – Released into the blood and used by other tissues as a *source of energy*

5.) BLOOD CELL PRODUCTION

- Cavities filled with red bone marrow
 - produces blood cells & platelets

EXTRACELLULAR MATRIX

- *Collagen (Tough rope-like proteins)*
- *Proteoglycans (Polysaccharides)*
- *Tendons (Collagen Fibers)*
- *Ligaments (Collagen Fibers)*
- *Cartilage (Collagen & Proteoglycans)*
- *Hydroxyapatite (Calcium Phosphate Crystals)*

GENERAL FEATURES OF BONE

1. LONG BONES

- Longer than they are wide

2. SHORT BONES

- Broad as they are long

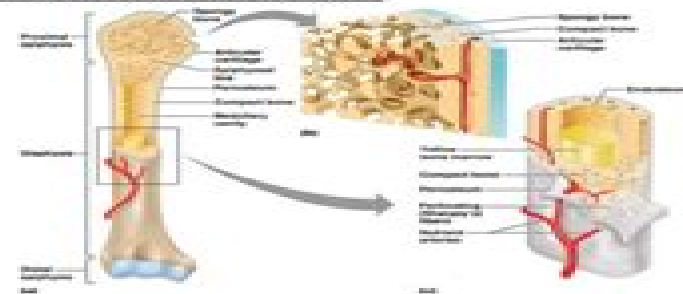
3. FLAT BONES

- Relatively thin, flattened shape

4. IRREGULAR BONES

- Vertebrae & Facial Bones

STRUCTURE OF A LONG BONE



• DIAPHYSIS

- Central Shaft

• EPIPHYSIS

- Two ends

• ARTICULAR CARTILAGE

- covers the ends of the epiphyses where the bone articulates with other bones.

• EPIPHYSEAL PLATE

- Growth plate, where the bone grows in length.
- Composed of cartilage, between each epiphysis and the diaphysis

• EPIPHYSEAL LINE

- When the bone growth stops, this replaces the epiphyseal plate.

• MEDULLARY CAVITY

- Large cavity in the diaphysis

• MARROW

- A soft tissue that fills the spaces
- **Yellow Marrow** – consist of mostly adipose tissues; **Red Marrow** – consist of blood-forming cell and is the only site of blood formation in adults.

• PERIOSTEUM

- Covers most of the outer surface of the bones
- Encloses the diaphysis
- Contains blood vessels and nerves

• ENDOSTEUM

- Thinner connective tissue membrane that lines the surface of the medullary cavity

Cell Chemistry and Physiology: Part III Edward Bittar, 1996-06-17 The first section of this volume consists of five chapters to the nature of membrane transport systems A chapter on secondary active glucose transport has been omitted because this topic is slated to appear in the Nephrobiology module Chapter 6 deals with oxidase control of plasma membrane proton transport while chapter 7 addresses the question of how cell volume is regulated Although we chose not to have a separate chapter covering additional co transport systems namely Na K 2Cl KCl HCO₃ as well as Cl HCO₃ exchange and K and Cl movements through channels the role of each in cell volume regulation is emphasized in Chapter 7 Instead of devoting an entire section to the thermodynamics of metabolism we thought it desirable to have the subjects of medical imaging and NMR of cell metabolism discussed in some detail in two chapters These are followed by a

chapter on the thermodynamic instrument the calorimeter Calrimetry allows the measurement of net changes of heat in cells tissues organs and whole body As will be recognized heat dissipation does not arise only from chemical reactions but also from interactions between macromolecules and conformational changes in protein complexes and mass Ca²⁺ movement such as that occurring in contracting skeletal muscle The last chapter provides an account of equilibrium and non equilibrium thermodynamics and the enthalpy balance method It reveals that calometric measurements are useful in studies of clinical and toxicological problems
