Geerken, 2025-05-07 Vor 57 Jahren wurde Horst H Geerken zum ersten Mal mit angeblichen Aktivitäten der deutschen Kriegsmarine in Indonesien konfrontiert Indonesische Freiheitskämpfer die sich nach dem Ende des Zweiten Weltkriegs gegen die Wiederkehr der niederländischen Streitkräfte zur Wehr gesetzt hatten erzählten ihm davon Während der 18 Jahre in denen er beruflich in Indonesien war forschte Horst H Geerken zu diesem Thema weiter und auch danach reiste er zu Recherchen regelmäßig in die Region Inzwischen konnte der Autor belegen dass die Aktivitäten der deutschen Streitkräfte in Asien wesentlich umfangreicher und intensiver waren als zunächst angenommen In Band 1 und 2 dieser Dokumentation sind viele neue bisher unbekannte Erkenntnisse eingeflossen über ein Thema das von der Geschichtsschreibung bislang weitgehend vernachlässigt wurde Schon kurz nach der Veröffentlichung der beiden Bände bekam der Autor unzählige Zuschriften von Menschen die entweder selbst im Zweiten Weltkrieg in das Kriegsgeschehen in Asien involviert waren oder deren Väter Großväter oder Ehemänner daran beteiligt gewesen waren Beide Bände sind zwischenzeitlich auch in Englisch erschienen eine Zusammenfassung auch in Bahasa Indonesia Auch der vorliegende Band 3 enthält viele neue Forschungsergebnisse Sie stammen ausschließlich von Zeitzeugen oder aus Archiven in Europa Australien und Indonesien sowie aus den wenigen Tagebüchern die den Zweiten Weltkrieg und die Internierung der deutschen Zivilisten in Niederländisch Indien und Britisch Indien bis heute überstanden haben *Hitler's Jewish Soldier* Bryan Mark Rigg, 2020-08-20 On the murderous road to racial purity Hitler encountered unexpected detours largely due to his own crazed views and inconsistent policies regarding Jewish identity After centuries of Jewish assimilation and intermarriage in German society he discovered that eliminating Jews from the rest of the population was more difficult than he'd anticipated As Bryan Rigg shows in this provocative new study nowhere was that heinous process more fraught with contradiction and confusion than in the German military Contrary to conventional views Rigg reveals that a startlingly large number of German military men were classified by the Nazis as Jews or partial Jews Mischlinge in the wake of racial laws first enacted in the mid 1930s Rigg demonstrates that the actual number was much higher than previously thought perhaps as many as 150 000 men including decorated veterans and high ranking officers even generals and admirals As Rigg fully documents for the first time a great many of these men did not even consider themselves Jewish and had embraced the military as a way of life and as devoted patriots eager to serve a revived German nation In turn they had been embraced by the Wehrmacht which prior to Hitler had given little thought to the race of these men but which was now forced to look deeply into the ancestry of its soldiers The process of investigation and removal however was marred by a highly inconsistent application of Nazi law Numerous exemptions were

Geerken,2025-05-23 From 1963 to 1981 Horst H Geerken lived in the new born Republic of Indonesia at a time of upheaval after the end of almost 350 years of colonial rule and exploitation by the Netherlands In both his professional and private activities he constantly came across German Japanese and Indonesian eyewitnesses who had lived through the Japanese occupation and the presence of the German navy in Indonesia The relations between the German Reich and what was then the Dutch East Indies were obviously closer and more varied than had been previously assumed Hardly anyone was aware that Hitler was extremely interested in this distant archipelago and that thousands of German officers and seamen were in action in East and South East Asia Who knows that German U boats and auxiliary cruisers penetrated deep into the Pacific and that the German Navy used the Kerguelen Islands in the South Polar Sea as a secret base Or that Hitler gave massive support to the independence movements in Indonesia and India Many of the German naval personnel chose to make Indonesia their home after the war and joined the Indonesian freedom fighters The Second World War heralded the

end of the colonial era in Asia especially in South East Asia The role played in this process by the Third Reich should not be underestimated The collaboration between the Axis powers especially that between German and Japan with all its problems is also investigated There was a lively exchange of new weapons technology There was even the re creation of a German Radar system in Japan under the management of a German engineer Documents from the Third Reich s Foreign Ministry published here for the first time show how brutally and inhumanely the German men women and children in the Dutch internment camps in the East Indies were treated by their captors These documents are supported by evidence from contemporary witnesses The author has encapsulated his many years of research in the two volumes of Hitler s Asian Adventure It is a fascinating documentation of the German Navy s involvement in a theatre of war that has until now been neglected by historians

Ballets Russes and with Igor Stravinsky he cocreated *The Rite of Spring* a landmark work in the emergence of artistic modernity His art his adventures and his peace activism earned the friendship and admiration of such diverse luminaries as Albert Einstein Eleanor Roosevelt H G Wells Jawaharlal Nehru Raisa Gorbacheva and H P Lovecraft But the artist also had a darker side Stravinsky once said of Roerich that he ought to have been a mystic or a spy He was certainly the former and close enough to the latter to blur any distinction His travels to Asia supposedly motivated by artistic interests and archaeological research were in fact covert attempts to create a pan Buddhist state encompassing Siberia Mongolia and Tibet His activities in America touched Franklin Delano Roosevelt s cabinet with scandal and behind the scenes affected the course of three US presidential elections In his lifetime Roerich baffled foreign affairs ministries and intelligence services in half a dozen countries He persuaded thousands that he was a humanitarian and divinely inspired thinker but convinced just as many that he was a fraud or a madman His story reads like an epic work of fiction and is all the more remarkable for being true John McCannon s engaging and scrupulously researched narrative moves beyond traditional perceptions of Roerich as a saint or a villain to show that he was in many ways both in equal measure
