Across Asserica, aniddle-class and upper-uniddle-class gated communities are creating new forms of exclusions and residencial segregation, exacerbating social cleavages that already exist (Blakely and Soyder 1997; Higley 1995; Lang and Danielson 1997; Marcose (997). While historically secured and gated communities were built in the United States to protect exacts and to contain the leisure world of settrees, these urbso and suburban developments now target a much broader market, including families with children (Guterson 1992; Lufland 1998). This retreat to secured enclaves with walls, gates, and guards materially and symbolically contradicts American others and values, threatens public acress to open space, and creases yet another burrier to should interaction, building of social networks, as well as increased tolerance of diverse call total/facial/social groups (Davis 1992; Devine 1996; Etanai 1995; Judi 1995; McKenzie 1994).

Understanding this spatial form, its historical and cultural centext, and

why residents choose to five there provides an inspectant perspective on the contral city that is often overlooked.

For a majority of Americans the distance from suburb to city, or from week to home, is maintained through a complex social discourse. Anti-urban sentiment is often expressed as fear of violence and crime that is said to pervade the city. Within eared communities, though, the intensity of the discourse of urban fear suggests other underlying socictal explanations. In this study, I explore the complex interestrangerions between this discourse, loss of a sense of place, and increasing class separation. I suggest that adding walls, gates, and guards produces a landscape that encodes class relations and residential (race/class/crtmic/servier) segregation more permanently in the built environment (Low 1997). Understanding how this landscare is logitimated by a discourse of fear of crime and violence beins to uncover how this design form is manerially and rhaterically created.

I use thematic content enalysis to document the exist ence of urban fear in its many forms and its influence on residents' residential narratives. Critical discourse analysis provides a complementary methodology for decoding talk about urban fear as an acceptable, socially constructed discourse about class exclusion and racial/ethnic/cultural bias.
