### II. Important People

- **Piaget:** Swiss psychologist who created theory of cognitive development to explain the processes by which humans come to perceive, organize knowledge, solve problems, and understand the world. According to this theory, human cognitive development is the product of a continuous, reliable pattern or plan of interaction with the environment. Humans are a culture. Humans are goal-oriented strategists that help the person achieve some intended result. There are human are autonomous (constructing his/her own early skills, in which culture and nature (genetics are prevalent) and cognition (based on experience and on mental images, reflecting the person's ability to develop the use of abstract reasoning and symbolism).
- **Erikson:** German psychologist who worked on human psychosocial development theory. Created 8 stages of life.
- **Sigmund Freud:** Proposed psychosexual, calling it both masculine and feminine for women. Freud, theory proposed that were important feelings of identity because they cannot give birth to children.
- **Western & Eastern:** Created another basic orientation, which the same on psychological matters, begins with non-specific teaching only, leads to genital teaching. Used to measure pleasure without pressure to perform early, or achieve orgasm.
- **John Turk and Virginia Mahoney:** started functional theory. They attributed to the school of life as P & M and influenced the work of Marshall Leary & Marie. This school was presented as contrast to the psychoanalytic school of thought (which was previously psychoanalytic).
- **Anna Freud:** worked on psychology
- **Willy Reich:** founder of gestalt theory
- **Skinner:** founder of operant conditioning theory
- **Carl Rogers:** founder of client-centered theory
- **Freud & Mahoney & Garfield:** founder of systems theory
- **Adlerman:** "Father of family therapy." He particularly used a psychoanalytic approach, insight oriented.
- **Kate & Whitaker:** Communication in family therapy. Mainly experiential (through experiential communication and interaction, awareness of self and how leading to personal accountability, and increasing patterns of interaction. Later focused on communication problems, double bind, faulty communication is caused by low self-esteem, and the presence of a parent that is authoritarian. Whitaker mostly oriented with awareness and discussed the transference phenomenon. Initially communication family therapy acknowledged that transference factors can provide a foundation for family problems, but they did not try to interpret these factors. Family therapy after founded the emphasis on communication patterning and often referred to as the "White Hat" group.
