While it is often argued that O'Hara is a forerunner of a new critically informed materialist poetics, this study concludes that O'Hara's work is somewhat less radical in its understanding of poetic meaning than is often claimed. Moreover, while O'Hara is preoccupied with his experience in his poems, the book argues that he espouses in some respects a rather traditional view of love. In addition to being a metaphor for the creative act, love for O'Hara is the chance coming together of two entities. Yet one of the ironies of this is that while love is for O'Hara a feeling that is the result of movement or the unexpected coming together of two otherwise separate entities.
