How to Deliver the Friday Khutbah

(The Khateeb stands on the mimbar or on the same level as the congregation, and says:

"Assalamu 'Alaikum"; (He sits down.)

Standing before the Imam, the Mu'adh-dhin says the Adhan

The Khateeb stands and says:

"A'uudhubillaaki mina-sh shaytaani-r rajeem, Bismillaaki-r Rahmaani-r Raheem

He praises and thanks Allah and sends blessings and greetings to Prophet Muhammad, peace be on him, to his family and to his companions, by saying:

"Al Hamdu Lillahi Rabbil 'Alameen." "Wa-ssalatu was-salamu 'alaSayyidinaa Muhammad wa 'ala aaliht wa Sahbihi ayna'een."

Saying "Amma ba'd" (roughly meaning 'Now to proceed', he then recites a verse or verses of the Our'an relating to the subject of his talk by saying:

Quala-l lashu Ta'asla fi kitasbihi-l majeed meaning 'Allah the Almighty has said in His Glorious Book'

He follows it with a Hadith from the Prophet about the subject he is going to talk about by saying: Wa quala rasuulu-l laahi - salla-l laahu 'alayhi wa sallam' and then the actual words of the hadith.

He then deals with the main theme of his khutbah.

8. He ends his first khutbah with an Ayah and a Hadith. It is preferable that they be recited in their original Arabic texts.

Before he sits down, he should ask the congregating Muslims to ask Allah for forgiveness, guidance and mercy. He should ask forgiveness for himself, also.

10. After a few moments of pause, he stands up and starts the second khutbah.

11. The second khutbah should start with praise to Allah, followed by blessings (Salat) and greeting (Salaam) to the Prophet, his family, his companions and unto their followers, by saying:

" Al Hamdu Lillahi Rabbil 'Alameen wa-s-salaatu wa-s-salaamu alaa sayyidinaa Muhammad wa 'ala Aalihi wa Sahbihi wa man wala."

12. It is preferable that the second khutbah be devoted to Du'a' (supplications).
