Modeling Fractional Outcomes with SAS[®]

Abstract

The generalized GLS (Generalized Linear Squares) regression with Gaussian distributional assumption has been the first choice to model fractional outcomes in many business problems. However, it is controversially argued as assuming Gaussian distribution for a response variable in the (0, 1) range. In this paper, several modeling techniques for fractional outcomes with their implementations in SAS should be discussed through a real-world example in modeling financial leverage ratio of businesses. The purpose of this paper is to provide a relatively comprehensive survey of how to model fractional outcomes in the SAS and comparing and contrasting fractional probabilities.

1. Introduction

In the financial services industry, an often-observed business assumption is model fractional outcomes in the range of (0, 1). For example, in the context of credit risk, L&L (Liu and Liang) (2016) recently discussed the properties of models not discussed from a default business during the subprime process, which is observed in the closed interval (0, 1). Another example is the corporate financial leverage ratio represented by the long-term debt as a proportion of the sum of total fixed and long-term debt and the equity.

Although somewhat progress in statistical models for fractional outcomes have achieved during the past years, there is still no general agreement on which the distributional assumption or the modeling practice. An interesting but somewhat tricky reply is that one simple GLS regression with Gaussian distributional assumption has achieved the most popular modeling model fractional outcomes due to its simplicity. However, the argument with GLS regression suffers from a couple of unreasonable flaws. First and the most evident of all, fractional outcomes in the (0, 1) range are not defined on the whole real line and therefore shouldn't be considered normally distributed. Moreover, a desirable consideration of fractional outcomes is that the observed is not independent of the model. For instance, the leverage ratios as the most generalized business points of (0, 1), which is nothing but a form of $\frac{Y}{1+Y}$.
