Returning to 1848 we can choose to look back on that springtime of the peoples as a moment of tragicomic failure obliterated by the brutalities that followed or we can look again and see it as a prophetic moment of stored potential, an extraordinary series of events that generated long distance and sustainable ideas about global citizenship, international co-operation and a shared and common humanity which have not yet been fully understood or realised.
