With growing trade in fish products, there is growing concern about the possible effects on developing country consumption and mutition [4].

Ethiopin is the largest livestock populations in the Africa. The livestock sector accounts for over 26 percent of agricultural ODP (2009/10) and 8 percent of export earnings (2010) and can produce over 51,500 tons of fish per ansum. However, their exploitation and consequently their contributions to food security and growth in the country are minimal despite the technologies capable of resolving the problems of livestock and fisheries production [5].

At present, the country Ethiopia has an estimated annual total exploitable fish potential of 51,481 tons, which can meet only 79 percent of the current actual demand, 55 percent of the projected demand in 2010 and 44 percent of the projected demand in 2015, based solely on population size [6].
