World Agriculture Towards 2030 2050 Fao:

Nachhaltige Flächennutzung für nachwachsende Rohstoffe Robert Busch, 2009-02 Neben Qualität und Quantität der Gewinnung von Materialien oder Energie ist die Fläche der wichtigste Wirtschaftsfaktor bei nachwachsenden Rohstoffen. In der Vergangenheit wurde die Nachhaltigkeit von nachwachsenden Rohstoffen insbesondere in Bezug auf die Umweltwirkungen des Anbaus hin untersucht. Ein Projekt am Wuppertal Institut für Klima, Umwelt und Energie, in welchem die vorliegende Studie eingebunden war, hat mit großem Aufwand zum ersten Mal die globalen Flächenaufwendungen Deutschlands untersucht, welche auftreten, wenn die quantitativen Nutzungsziele nachwachsender Rohstoffe bis 2030 realisiert werden. Das Ergebnis dabei ist eine erschreckende Flächenverknappung. Ziel der hiesigen Studie war es nun zu analysieren, inwiefern als notwendig erachtete alternative Flächenpotenziale freigesetzt werden können, wenn weniger tierisch basierte Nahrungsmittel in der BRD produziert bzw. konsumiert werden. Die globalen Flächenfreisetzungen in der Landwirtschaft ergeben sich hierbei aus dem geringeren Bedarf an Tierfutter. Der größte Teil des Tierfutterbedarfs der BRD wird durch Selbsterzeugung in Deutschland gedeckt, wobei der Großteil der verfügbaren landwirtschaftlichen Flächen hierfür genutzt wird. In zwei Kapiteln der Studie wird einerseits das Thema der Flächenverfügbarkeit erörtert, andererseits wird ausführlich die in Nutzungspfaden Ziele und Umweltwirkungen von nachwachsenden Rohstoffen eingeführt. In dem analytischen Teil der Studie wird zum einen produktionsseitig die Herstellung von Futtermitteln in Deutschland bis 2030 untersucht. Auf der Konsumseite wird der unter bestimmten Annahmen prognostizierte Verbrauch tierisch basierter Nahrungsmittel für diesen Zeitraum berechnet. Für beide Seiten wird die jeweilige globale Inanspruchnahme landwirtschaftlicher Flächen bzw. das eventuelle Freisetzungspotenzial aus den projizierten Entwicklungen ermittelt. Abschließend folgen eine Bewertung der Ergebnisse im Rahmen der Fragestellungen zu den Flächenpotenzialen.

World Agriculture Towards 2030/2050 Nikos Alexandratos, 2012 Demonstrates that the perceived limits to producing food for a growing global population have been a source of debate and preoccupations for ages. Aims to provide insights into how the situation may develop to 2050 based on the exogenous assumption that world gross domestic product (GDP) will be 2.5 fold the present one and per capita income will be 1.8 fold. Presents a remake of Chapters 1-3 of the Interim Report *World Agriculture towards 2030-2050* FAO 2006. In addition includes a Chapter 4 on production factors: land, water, yields, fertilizers. Revised and more recent data have been used as basis for the new projections.

Prospects for Soil Regeneration and Its Impact on Environmental Protection Sesan Abiodun Aransiola,Babafemi Raphael Babaniyi,Adejoke Blessing Aransiola,Naga Raju Maddela,2024-02-26 Soil is a complex system of inorganic and organic materials living organisms water and air It is home to more than one trillion species of microorganisms Soil also plays an important role in the global carbon cycle Because plants absorb carbon from the atmosphere convert it to plant tissue and return it to the soil as plant residue soils globally act as the world s largest sink of active carbon Soil has role to play in food production and safety Soil contamination undermined by modern agricultural practices that deplete soil carbon stocks Anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions have been raising recorded temperatures since the Industrial Revolution Greenhouse gas emissions from agriculture forestry and fisheries have

almost doubled in the last 50 years and will increase by 30% by 2050 given the current trend The primacy of arresting climate change is nowhere more evident than the adoption of 195 countries of the first legally binding global climate deal at the Paris Climate Conference in 2015 With atmospheric carbon dioxide CO₂ reaching 400 parts per million in 2016 soils can be an ally in bringing the CO₂ level down to a sustainable level if protected for regeneration Soil protection and regeneration is a technique that involves the conservative rehabilitation of soil ecosystem and farmland This technique focuses on top soil regeneration improving the water cycle supporting biosequestration enhancing ecosystem services increasing biodiversity strengthening the vitality and health of farm soil and increasing resilience to climate change and landscape Environmental protection not only improves soil health productivity and resilience to weather extremes raising farm yields and income while strengthening regional food security in the face of a changing climate but can also form part of a region's broader climate strategy This book is timely as more studies and reviews need to be reported about regenerating global polluted soil and the impacts on the environment the benefit of both biotic and abiotic structure thereby creating more awareness of environmental protection and sustainability Thus this book presents a vista to research on regeneration of lost resources in the soil and its impacts on the environment

Sustainable Irrigation Development in the White Volta sub-Basin Eric Antwi Ofosu, 2011-12-16 Sub Saharan Africa has an irrigation potential of about 42 million hectares of which only 17% is developed Despite several investments in irrigation the growth is slow This study aims at helping to achieve sustainable irrigation in sub Saharan Africa through gaining a better understanding of productive irrigation water use and effective management of irrigation development The study is conducted in the White Volta sub basin specifically in Northern Ghana and Southern Burkina Faso which have been experiencing rapid irrigation development since the mid 1990s The study identified growing markets for irrigated products as an important driving force behind the expansion of irrigation which has given rise to new technologies The new technologies have spread because they gave farmers direct control over water sources These new technologies allow relatively small farm sizes which can be adequately managed by the surveyed farmers As a result high productivities are achieved The hydrological impact of upscaling irrigation in the sub basin is sustainable and will maximize the overall benefits derived from water resources in the Volta Basin
