Barbarossa Derailed: The Battle for Smolensk 10 July-10 September 1941 David Glantz, 2010-11-02 The first half of a two part study on Operation Barbarossa Hitler's plan to invade Soviet Russia during World War II and what went wrong At dawn on 10 July 1941 massed tanks and motorized infantry of German Army Group Center's Second and Third Panzer Groups crossed the Dnepr and Western Dvina Rivers beginning what Hitler and most German officers and soldiers believed would be a triumphal march on Moscow the Soviet capital Less than three weeks before on 22 June Hitler had unleashed his Wehrmacht's massive invasion of the Soviet Union code named Operation Barbarossa which sought to defeat the Soviet Red Army conquer the country and unseat its Communist ruler Josef Stalin Between 22 June and 10 July the Wehrmacht advanced up to 500 kilometers into Soviet territory killed or captured up to one million Red Army soldiers and reached the western banks of the Western Dvina and Dnepr Rivers by doing so satisfying the premier assumption of Plan Barbarossa that the Third Reich would emerge victorious if it could defeat and destroy the bulk of the Red Army before it withdrew to safely behind those two rivers With the Red Army now shattered Hitler and most Germans expected total victory in a matter of weeks The ensuing battles in the Smolensk region frustrated German hopes for quick victory Once across the Dvina and Dnepr Rivers a surprised Wehrmacht encountered five fresh Soviet armies Quick victory eluded the Germans Instead Soviet forces encircled in Mogilev and Smolensk stubbornly refused to surrender and while they fought on during July August and into early September first five and then a total of seven newly mobilized Soviet armies struck back viciously at the advancing Germans conducting multiple counterattacks and counterstrokes capped by two major counteroffensives that sapped German strength and will Despite immense losses in men and materiel these desperate Soviet actions derailed Operation Barbarossa Smarting from countless wounds inflicted on his vaunted Wehrmacht even before the fighting ended in the Smolensk region Hitler postponed his march on Moscow and instead turned his forces southward to engage softer targets in the Kiev region The derailment of the Wehrmacht at Smolensk ultimately became the crucial turning point in Operation Barbarossa This groundbreaking study now significantly expanded exploits a wealth of Soviet and German archival materials including the combat orders and operational of the German OKW OKH army groups and armies and of the Soviet Stavka the Red Army General Staff the Western Main Direction Command the Western Central Reserve and Bryansk Fronts and their subordinate armies to present a detailed mosaic and definitive account of what took place why and how during the prolonged and complex battles in the Smolensk region from 10 July through 10 September 1941 The structure of the study is designed specifically to appeal to both general readers and specialists by a detailed two volume chronological narrative of the course of operations accompanied by a third volume and a fourth containing archival maps and an extensive collection of specific orders and reports translated verbatim from Russian The maps archival and archival based detail every stage of the battle

The German Fallschirmtruppe 1936-41 (Revised edition) Karl-Heinz Golla, 2013-07-19 The Fallschirmtruppe of the Wehrmacht won recognition for their valor and endurance not only from their fellow German soldiers but from their former enemies as well. Franco-Prussian War 1870-1871, Volume 1 Quintin Barry, 2007-03-19 The first volume of this comprehensive study of the Franco-Prussian War presents a detailed account of Germany's decisive victory over France. The Battle for Moscow David Stahel, 2015-01-22 In November 1941 Hitler ordered German forces to complete the final drive on the Soviet capital now less than 100 kilometres away. Army Group Centre was pressed into the attack for one last attempt to break Soviet resistance before the onset of winter. From the German perspective the final drive on Moscow had all the ingredients of a dramatic final battle in the east which according to previous accounts only failed at the gates of Moscow. David Stahel challenges this well-established narrative by demonstrating that the last German offensive of 1941 was a forlorn effort undermined by operational weakness and poor logistics and driven forward by what he identifies as National Socialist military thinking. With unparalleled research from previously undocumented army files and soldiers' letters Stahel takes a fresh look at the battle for Moscow which even before the Soviet winter offensive threatened disaster for Germany's war in

Pyl'cyn,2009-04-28 From a decorated officer an extremely rare account of a World War II Soviet military unit comprised of prisoners of war Made up of soldiers who conducted unauthorized retreats former POWs deemed untrustworthy and Gulag prisoners the Red Army's penal units carried out some of the most terrifying assignments on the Eastern Front such as storming German machine gun nests Alexander Pyl'cyn led his penal company in the Soviets massive offensive in the summer of 1944 the Vistula Oder operation into eastern Germany and the bitter assault on Berlin in 1945 He survived the war but 80 percent of his men did not Alexander Pyl'cyn drafted into the Red Army at eighteen in 1941 and wounded three times earned the Order of the Red Banner the Order of the Great Patriotic War and the Order of the Red Star for his actions during World War II Adventures in My Youth Armin Schedierbauer,2013-03-20 The personal memoir of a Nazi soldier from joining the German Army in 1941 through his time as a Panzer on the Eastern Front Originally written only for his daughter Armin Schedierbauer's *Adventures in My Youth* chronicles his time as a soldier during World War II As an infantry officer with the 252nd Infantry Division German Army Schedierbauer saw four years of combat on the Eastern Front After joining his unit during the winter of 1942 he was wounded six times and had firsthand experience of the Soviet offensives in the summer of 1944 and January 1945 While fighting in East Prussia he was captured by the Soviets and not released until 1947 Schedierbauer was only twenty one years old when the war ended and his memoir recollects the experiences he went through as a young man on the front *In the Fire of the Eastern Front* Hendrick Verton,2012-02-29 Dutch SS accounts are very rare particularly ones such as this covering recruitment training and frontline service first with 5th SS Panzer Division Wiking then later with SS Regiment Besslein He not only informs and illustrates the general politics of the time but also explains how Dutch views of the Third Reich changed so radically discusses the founding of the Waffen SS the recruitment of Dutch volunteers into it and why so many non German Europeans volunteered to fight and risk their lives for Germany His discussion of the intensity of the SS's training is also noteworthy Of course the core of the book lies in Hendrik's recollections of his service on the Eastern Front between 1941 and 1945 initially with the 5th SS Panzer Division Wiking He offers the reader an impressive and fluid account whether it be describing the midst of battle surviving 50 degrees below zero frosts and frozen ground or traversing a quagmire of roads Of particular historical interest are his later recollections of service during 1944-45 with SS Regiment Besslein on the Eastern Front focusing on his participation in the epic defense of Breslau this siege remains little known in the West and first hand accounts such as Hendrik's are even scarcer making this title a worthy addition to the literature on the Second World War **Twilight of the Gods** Thorolf Hillblad,2004-05-19 A rare first hand account from a Swedish Waffen SS soldier who fought against the Red Army on the Eastern Front during World War II Few new personal accounts by Waffen SS soldiers appear in English even fewer originate from the multitude of non German European volunteers who formed such an important proportion of this service's manpower *Twilight of the Gods* was originally written in Swedish and published in Buenos Aires shortly after the

end of WWII It is the story of Erik Wallin a Swedish soldier who volunteered for service with the Waffen SS and participated in the climactic battles on the Eastern Front during late 1944 and 1945 as told to this book's editor Thorolf Hillblad Wallin served with the Panzer Reconnaissance Battalion 11th SS Panzergrenadier Division Nordland a unit composed mainly of non German volunteers including Danes Norwegians and Swedes The division enjoyed a high reputation for its combat capability and was always at the focal points of the fighting on the Eastern Front in the last year of the war During this period it saw combat in the Baltic in Pomerania on the Oder and finally in defense of Berlin where it was destroyed Erik Wallin served with his unit in all of these locations and provides the reader with a fascinating glimpse into these final battles The book is written with a no holds barred approach which will captivate excite and maybe even shock the reader his recollections do not evade the brutality of fighting against the advancing Red Army Twilight of the Gods is destined to become a classic memoir of the Second World War

The Role of the Soviet Union in the Second World War Boris Sokolov, 2013-04-24 This book investigates several controversial issues regarding the role of the Soviet Union and the performance of the Soviet government and Red Army to which the author provides some provocative answers The primary question explored by the author however regards the effectiveness of both the Red Army and of the Soviet military economy Dr Sokolov argues that the chief defect of the Soviet military economy was the disproportionate emphasis on the production of tanks and aircraft at the expense of transportation means and the means of command and control This leads the author to look at the role of Lend Lease during the war Through the delivery of radio sets trucks jeeps locomotives fuel explosives and so on the author concludes that Lend Lease was critical to the Red Army and that the Soviet Union would not have been able to wage a long war against Germany without the Lend Lease supplies a conclusion that defies decades of Soviet claims to the contrary Finally the author looks at the still very controversial and hot topic of Red Army losses in the war which was taboo for decades arguing that this is an effective measure of the Red Army's military performance He and other scholars have estimated that the Red Army's losses were on the scale of 27 million three times larger than the official estimates and approximately 10 times greater than the German losses on the Eastern Front He argues that such horrendous casualties and such an unfavorable ratio for the Red Army were the result of the relatively low value placed on human life in both the Russian Empire and the Soviet Union and the much more destructive nature of the Soviet totalitarian regime as compared with the Third Reich which cowed the Soviet generals and officers into total subservience Due to the elimination of all political opposition and the total control over people's lives soldiers and civilians could not protest against the crude tactics that resulted in such a very high rate of losses Dr Boris Sokolov is a prolific author and a member of the Russian branch of PEN International which celebrates literature and promotes freedom of expression In 2008 Dr Sokolov was forced to resign as Professor of Social Anthropology from his post at the Russian State Social University in Moscow at the demand of President Medvedev's administration after publishing an article about the 2008 Russian Georgian

Ice Steel and Fire Linda Parker, 2013-07-19 The generation that reached maturity in the inter war years had grown up in the shadow of the heroic age of Polar exploration and the sacrifices of a generation in the Great War Their own adventures were to prove as astonishing and heroic as those of a previous generation The members of the British Arctic air route expedition to Greenland including Martin Lindsay Quintin Riley and Freddie Spencer Chapman were to pioneer the weather research methods necessary for Trans Atlantic Flight The university expeditions to Spitsbergen led by George Binney in the 1920s and Sandy Glen in the 1930s traversed and surveyed unexplored ground and contributed to developments in polar flight and radar Glen s expeditions added to the knowledge of Arctic conditions by over wintering Other pre war exploits of these adventurers included a voyage around the world the wrong way and participation in the British Graham Land Antarctic expedition Peter Fleming brother to the creator of James Bond Ian Fleming spent the 1930s exploring Brazil China and Tartary Fleming s exploits are recounted in detail in this book The character skills and endurance obtained in these years set these adventurers and explorers apart as men who were to play a distinguished and heroic role in the Second World War Their expertise in Arctic conditions small boat handling and exploring in all climatic conditions resulted in their participation in all aspects of warfare and arenas of battle particularly as exponents of special operations and as key members of Britain s first special forces Their war service took them from the fjords of Norway and Spitsbergen to the jungles of Burma and Malaya and the beaches of Normandy and Italy They were involved in blockade running covert operations in Yugoslavia Corsica and France and took part in major initiatives such as Ian Fleming s Intelligence gathering

force No 30 Assault unit and the raid on St Nazaire Most of these men had known each other before war came in 1939 In some cases they ended up serving alongside one another in wartime The intertwined stories of these characters in peace and war are examples of how the spirit of adventure shown by men in the inter war years contributed to Britain s outstanding role in the Second World War Linda Parker has written an important study that is equally relevant to both the history of British exploration and the genesis and early days of Britain s special forces 1939 45 a quite unique and hitherto unexamined relationship Linda Parker combines teaching History on a part time basis with her writing and is currently completing a PhD at Birmingham University Her main areas of interest are 20th Century Military History Church History and the History of Polar exploration She is a member of the Western Front Association She was born and educated in Wales but now lives in Oxfordshire with her husband and their dog She enjoys walking and travelling ideally together and her ambition is to visit Antarctica Her first book published by Helion was The Whole Armour of God Anglican Army Chaplains in the Great War 2009

Operation Typhoon David Stahel, 2015-01-22 In October 1941 Hitler launched Operation Typhoon the German drive to capture Moscow and knock the Soviet Union out of the war As the last chance to escape the dire implications of a winter campaign Hitler directed seventy five German divisions almost two million men and three of Germany s four panzer groups into the offensive resulting in huge victories at Viaz ma and Briansk among the biggest battles of the Second World War David Stahel s groundbreaking new account of Operation Typhoon captures the perspectives of both the German high command and individual soldiers revealing that despite success on the battlefield the wider German war effort was in far greater trouble than is often acknowledged Germany s hopes of final victory depended on the success of the October offensive but the autumn conditions and the stubborn resistance of the Red Army ensured that the capture of Moscow was anything but certain Hitler's Soldiers Ben H. Barry,2012-08-15 When Russia declared war on the Ottoman Empire in April 1877 it was the fifth time during the nineteenth century that hostilities had broken out between the two empires On this occasion the other Great Powers had done all they could to prevent it although public opinion in the West had been shocked by Turkey s brutal repression of the Bulgarian uprising The war was to be fought in two distinct theaters In Europe as on previous occasions the Russian objective was to cross first the Danube and then the formidable Balkan Mountains before striking for Constantinople In Asia over territory also contested many times before the Russians aimed to seize Kars and then Erzerum At first all went well for the invaders the Turks making no serious attempt to hold the line of the Danube while a thrust south by General Gourko succeeded in crossing the Balkans by a pass not previously considered practicable At Plevna however the Russian advance stalled in the face of the determined defense of the place by the redoubtable Osman Pasha In Asia meanwhile after initial success the Russian advance was halted by defeat at Zevin Poor strategic judgment on the part of the Turks led to their failure to take advantage of the opportunity provided by Osman even after the Russians had suffered three bloody defeats at Plevna Eventually after the town was closely invested it fell to the besiegers In Asia the Turks suffered a major defeat in the battle of God s Mountain and were driven back to Erzerum while Kars fell to a brilliant assault by the Russian forces These defeats marked the beginning of the end for the Turks By January 1878 the Russians were over the Balkans in force and the last viable Turkish army was surrounded and captured at Shenovo Armistice negotiations led to a suspension of hostilities and to the treaty of San Stefano The other Great Powers had watched the conflict with mounting anxiety and were determined to moderate the terms of San Stefano which had imposed harsh conditions on the Ottoman Empire This following tortuous diplomatic negotiations they succeeded in doing at the Congress of Berlin in July 1878 This book the first military history of the war in English for over a century traces the course of the campaigns examining the many occasions on which the outcome of a battle might have gone the other way and the performance of the combatants both leaders and led The book considers the extent to which the parties applied the lessons of recent wars as well as the conclusions that could be drawn from the experience of combat with the latest weapons It also explores the complicated motives of the Great Powers in general and Britain in particular in bringing about a final settlement which postponed the dissolution of the Ottoman Empire The author s detailed text is accompanied by an extensive number of black and white illustrations an impressive color plate section containing reproductions of paintings by artists such as Vereshchagin plus black and white and color battle maps Extensive orders of battle are also provided This is the latest title in Helion s ground breaking series of 19th Century studies and will again appear in hardback as a strictly limited edition printing of 1 000 copies each individually numbered and signed by the author on a decorative title page Wasted Years, Wasted Lives Volume 1 Ken Wharton,2013-07-19 The first volume in this two part oral history brings to life the experiences of British Army soldiers during the Troubles in the mid 1970s British Army veteran Ken Wharton has written extensively on the bitter conflict in Northern Ireland shedding light on the
