Providing extensive analysis of the various versions of Fichte's Science of Knowledge, Henrich brings into view a constellation of problems that illuminate the accomplishments of the founders of Romanticism: Novalis and Friedrich Schlegel and of the poet Hölderlin's original philosophy. He concludes with an interpretation of the basic design of Hegel's system.
