Herbivores

Have a complex stomach with four compartments

Long

Do not produce enzymes for protein digestion

Have two blunt canines

Premolars and molars move in the lateral direction

Produce more saliva with no carbohydrate digestive enzymes

Undergo regurgitation

Liver is large

Take a longer time to digest plant material

Digest all plant carbohydrates including cellulose

Ex: cattle, sheep, goats, buffalo, deer, etc.

NON RUMINANT ANIMALS

Animals that digest food in one stomach

Omnivores or carnivores

Have a simple stomach with a single compartment

Short

Produce enzymes for protein digestion

Have four sharp canines

Premolars and molars move in the vertical direction

Produce less saliva with carbohydrate digestive enzymes

Do not undergo regurgitation

Liver is smaller

Take comparatively less time for their digestion

Do not digest cellulose
