methodology developed in these guidelines is to introduce a harmonized international approach for assessing the impacts of livestock on biodiversity. At the same time livestock production is one of the few sectors with not only negative but also positive impacts on biodiversity therefore the sector can pull two levers to improve its biodiversity performance mitigate harm and maximize benefits. Many environmental assessments of the livestock sector have not addressed biodiversity because of its intrinsic complexity. These guidelines strive to include biodiversity in environmental assessments in order to increase the understanding of the impacts of livestock on biodiversity and to reveal possible synergies or trade offs with other environmental criteria or Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Several indicators in these guidelines are also of relevance for the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration.
