Chapter 1: The Project

This chapter describes how project-based work differs from 'regular' work.

1.1 Types of activities, types of work

There are three groups of activities within an organization.

1. Improvised activities
2. Routine activities
3. Project based activities

Improvised activities

People improvise when something unforeseen occurs that requires immediate attention. Their reaction will be *ad hoc*: not according to a laid down plan but decided on as events unfold.

Pros: It is flexible

Cons: its chaotic and could put the organization under a lot of pressure

Routine activities

Activities that are repeated frequently and are relatively predictable. The work will be carried out according to predetermined patterns.

In order to be able to perform these routine activities efficiently, *work procedures* have to be developed.

Project based

Fall roughly midway between improvised and routine; They are non-recurring and have limited duration but are reasonably predictable. To increase predictability, work is done *according to a plan*. What are the aims and how to achieve them.

(large) Projects are divided in *phases*. After each phase, the aims and procedure may be adjusted

A *project plan* is formulated at the start of a project that gives instructions, and some degree of routine can be introduced.
