

➤ Heating load calculations:

- There are two kinds of heat losses:
 - a) The heat transmitted through the walls, ceiling, floor, glass, or other surfaces;
 - b) The heat required to warm outdoor air entering the space.
- One has to estimate only the sensible and latent heat losses from the building walls, roof, ground, windows, doors, due to infiltration and ventilation.
- The actual heat loss problem is transient because the outdoor temperature, wind velocity, and sunlight are constantly changing.
- However, the difference may not be very high as long as the internal heat generation is not very large (i.e., when the building is not internally loaded).
