responses to the crisis at operating level with a focus on efficiency effectiveness and sustainability while assessing the relevance and consistency of the regional approach from a strategic perspective The evaluation team visited many of the areas concerned and at the end of each visit they organized a debriefing session with the respective FAO country team to share information gathered and collect complementary data and analysis to inform its deliberations This helped to ensure transparency in the data collection process and to maximize the learning process For FAO to support the food security and nutrition of communities in the Lake Chad region effectively a regional strategy focused on supporting the resilience of communities is relevant and appropriate Complementary to FAO s country based programmes a regional strategy bears the potential to devise interventions that adapt to the cross border nature of issues that each country faces and would allow supporting a more cohesive and collaborative way of working Based on the Regional Response Strategy 2017 2019 FAO should revise its strategy and approach by incorporating governmental objectives and translate it into an operational action plan in line with other partners strategies in the region
