The BRIEF-2 is a rating scale that assesses a child's executive functioning behavior in eight separate areas including: planning, organizing, initiating tasks, inhibiting impulses, emotional control, and flexibility and sustaining working memory. The executive functions are mental processes that direct one's thought, action, and emotion, particularly during active problem solving. T-scores at or above 65 should be considered as having potential clinical significance.

* T-scores between 65 and 69 are considered to be **moderately elevated**

** T-scores 70 and higher are considered **clinically significant**
