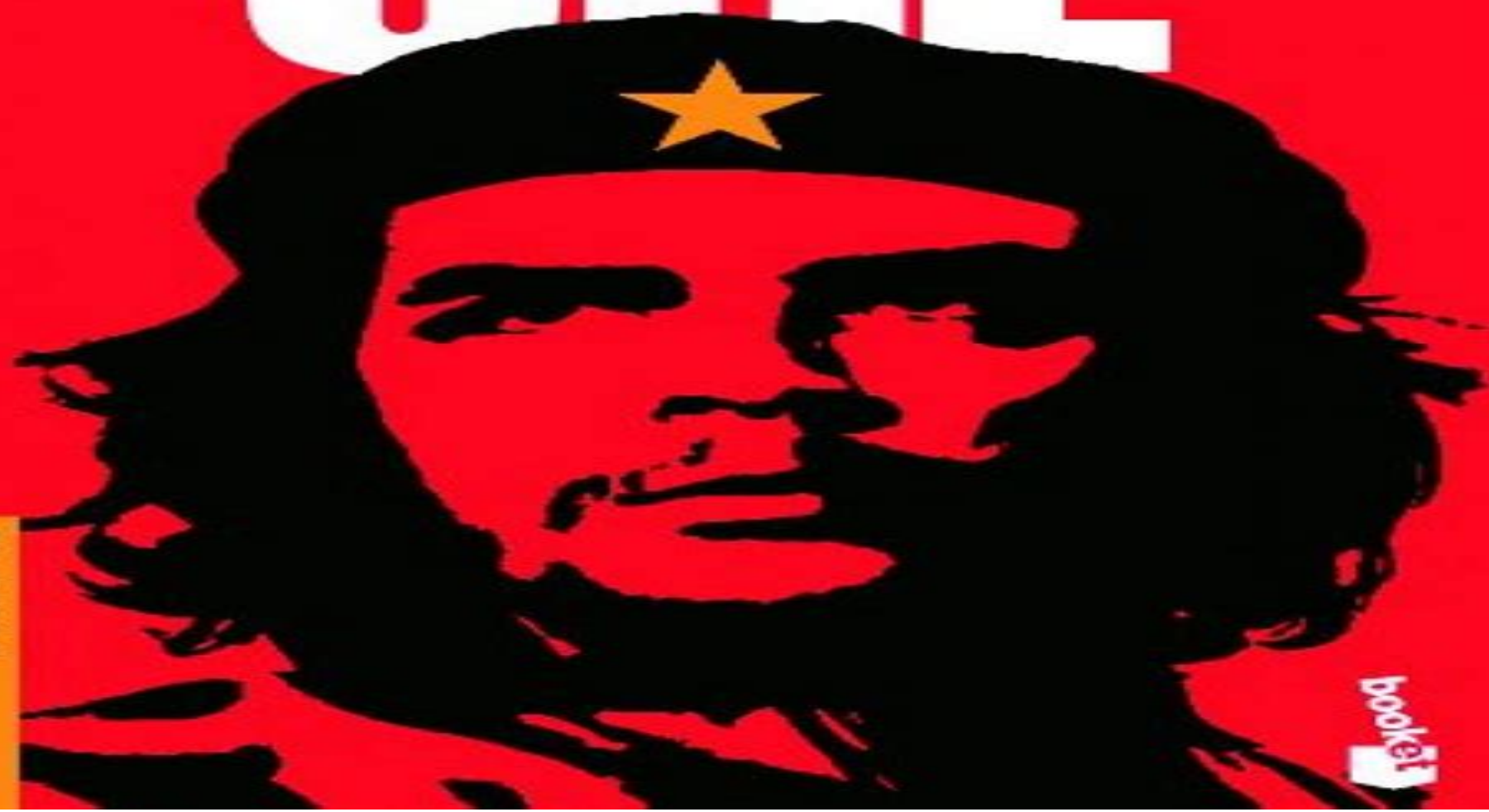

para más tarde con sólo treinta y seis años enfrentarse a un pelotón de fusilamiento en Honduras. Esta paradoja subyace a las dialécticas de la revolución en tanto se pasa del pueblo como sujeto de la política al pueblo como objeto de la política del instantáneo evento revolucionario al interminable rígin revolucionario de la politización del arte a la estetización de la política. Situar la Revolución cubana en el gran contexto histórico al que pertenece ese siglo marcado por el deseo radical de superar la separación del arte y la política propia de la sociedad burguesa permite echar luz no sólo sobre el arte revolucionario en Cuba socialista sino también sobre la revolución misma como obra de arte. Ella que pretendía superar junto con el mercado el tipo de alienación que la tradición marxista ha llamado reificación o espectáculo se convierte en mercancía y puesta en escena especie de artefacto producido y consumido en un círculo vicioso. Por esta cooptación de la fuerza de las masas en dictadura revolucionaria la revolución cubana resulta como la francesa y la rusa una revolución congelada. Pero también lo es en un segundo sentido el que comportan sus paradójicos efectos conservadores particularmente manifiestos tras la caída del muro de Berlín. Allí donde forzando el libreto pautado por la propia Unión Soviética una vez se pretendió construir simultáneamente el socialismo y el comunismo viejos edificios y carros americanos nos devuelven a los años anteriores al partearguas de 1959. Es justo la pasión

de lo real ese radicalismo que en los sesenta se manifiesta en la voluntad de abolir por igual el mercado capitalista y la autonomía burguesa del arte lo que desemboca en la profunda melancolía de unas ruinas artizadas auríticas tan fotográficas como las propias multitudes enardecidas de 1959 y 1960 La ruina habanera no tipifica entonces el momento posterior a la revolución sino que viene a ser en otra peripecia dialéctica la revolución misma Revolución no traicionada sino más bien congelada que aún no termina

[Dissonance in the U.S. Cuban Post-Exile Novel](#) Gregory Helmick, 2016-01-14 Archival Dissonance in the U.S. Cuban Post Exile Novel documents a body of emergent US Cuban literature published in Spanish and English beyond the scope and historicity of exile Focusing on the work of Roberto G. Fernández Ana Menéndez and Antonio Benítez Rojo the book proposes that rather than reinforce US Cuban exile ethnic identity developed between 1960 and the 1980s or demonstrate a tendency toward cultural assimilation Americanization over three generations of writers the discussed historical novels incorporate Caribbean and Latin American archival sources and interpretive frameworks in order to develop a critical and investigative approach to the politics of Cuban exile historiography Published before the recent apertura between the US and Cuban governments these post exile novels anticipate themes of displacement migration and social marginalization as common rather than exceptional features of modern and historical life as well as such other current and historical topics as gender construction and performance figurations of race the commoditization of culture and urban poverty The post exile historical novel points to a future for US Cuban narrative and historiography in part by investigating and featuring dissonances hidden or unacknowledged in previous Cuban exile historical fiction The literature studied in this book further reinforces a view of two way migration between Cuba and the United States as a normal phenomenon predating 1959 and at the same time as a likely shape of things to come **Espejos de la guerra fría** Daniela Spenser, 2004 **Che Guevara** Jon Lee

Unlike many observers who treat Cuba's revolutionary leaders as having merely reacted to U.S. policies or domestic socioeconomic conditions, Farber shows that revolutionary leaders, while acting under serious constraints, were nevertheless autonomous agents pursuing their own independent ideological visions, although not necessarily according to a master plan. Exploring how historical conflicts between U.S. and Cuban interests colored the reactions of both nations' leaders after the overthrow of Fulgencio Batista, Farber argues that the structure of Cuba's economy and politics in the first half of the twentieth century made the island ripe for radical social and economic change, and the ascendant Soviet Union was on hand to provide early assistance. Taking advantage of recently declassified U.S. and Soviet documents, as well as biographical and narrative literature from Cuba, Farber focuses on three key years to explain how the Cuban rebellion rapidly evolved from a multiclass antidictatorial movement into a full-fledged social revolution.

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
