Step 1 Identify the maximum and minimum values. The maximum height is 9 feet. The minimum height is 4 feet.
Step 2 Identify the vertical shift, k.

$$k = \frac{(\text{maximum value}) + (\text{minimum value})}{2}$$

$$= \frac{9+4}{2} = \frac{13}{2} = 6.5$$
Step 3 Decide whether the height should be modeled by a sine or cosine function. When $t = 0$, the height is a

sine or cosine function. When t = 0, the height is at its minimum. So, use a cosine function whose graph is a reflection in the x-axis with no horizontal shift (h = 0).

Step 4 Find the amplitude and period.

The amplitude is
$$|a| = \frac{\text{(maximum value)} - \text{(minimum value)}}{2}$$

$$= \frac{9-4}{2} = 2.5.$$

Because the graph is a reflection in the x-axis, a < 0. So, a = -2.5. Because the flywheel is rotating at a rate of 1 revolution per 2 seconds, one revolution is completed in 2 seconds. So, the period is $\frac{2\pi}{b} = 2$, and $b = \pi$.

A model for the height of the handle is $h = -2.5 \cos \pi t + 6.5$.
